The New Mexico Human Services Department's Medical Assistance Division provides no-cost or low-cost health insurance to New Mexico's uninsured and financially-eligible citizens. The Medical Assistance Division's goals are to reduce the overall number of uninsured New Mexicans and to ensure access to medically necessary services for eligible individuals.

Programs include health insurance coverage for pregnant women, children, working disabled individuals, financially-eligible families, employees of nonprofit organizations and small businesses. All coverage options are available through traditional Medicaid programs, the State's Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP), and *Insure New Mexico!* Solutions.

Administered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of New Mexico.	Employers contribute at least 50% of employees' monthly premium.	Premium determined by age, gender, and geographic location. PREMIUM ASSISTANCE FOR KIDS (PAK)	Uninsured children 0-12, and up to age 18 if part of a sibling group with a member who is 12 or younger. Must be ineligible for Medicaid due to income.	Comprehensive benefit package for children, including preventive, primary and specialty care.	Two participating carriers: Presbyterian and Lovelace Insurance Companies.	Not applicable. PREMIUM ASSISTANCE FOR MATERNITY (PAM)	Uninsured pregnant women who are ineligible for Medicaid due to income or have insurance that does not include maternity coverage.	Pregnancy-related coverage, including pre- and post-natal care.	All New Mexico medical providers who accept Medicaid reimbursement.	Not applicable. Three comprehensive plans (HMO, PPO and Indemnity packages). PPO and Indemnity have a maximum lifetime benefit of \$2,000,000. HMO plan has an unlimited lifetime benefit.
